



## Notice of intent to adjust parking time limits

# DOWNTOWN PARKING

### Notice for Perry Street north of Fourth Street



The intent of this notice is to provide opportunity for public comment prior to a Downtown parking time limits being adjusted in the location shown in the above photo illustration. This location is on the east side of Perry Street, north of Fourth Street.

The spot lined in green would be impacted by the change. The change would convert that spot from all-day parking to 2-Hour parking. That provision would be enforced to the extent possible by Castle Rock Police Department on Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The proposed change would not impact the other three parking spots along the east side of Perry Street, north of Fourth Street, which would remain all-day parking spots.

Any comments regarding this proposed parking time limit adjustment must be submitted in writing to the Castle Rock Town Manager's Office, 100 N.
